TREASURER'S REPORT: February YTD financial reports presented and reviewed

TOWN CREW REPORT: Superintendent T.Fleming reported the following:

Road limits will be placed on at 9AM March 8th, as per following Price County, exceptions will be handled on a case by case basis.

Work has been completed on right of way clearing project, N.Boruta Rd.

Correspondence regarding Forest Rd closures will be followed no later than March 15th, per request from the Chequamegan-Nicolet National Forest Civil Engineer

Springstead Bridge Project has a new completion time line of 2022 per Justin Blake

TRANSFER SITES REPORT: No current issues to report

<u>UPDATE ON FUND RAISING PERMITS:</u> Towns Association and Horton insurance concur we can issue permits, as long as, CDC rules and guidelines are followed regarding Covid-19

TOWN HALL SIGNAGE: The Handicap signs will remain in place, however based on severe unlevel approach, stenciling may need to be done away from building. Research will be done regarding the ability to have two Handicap parking areas and guidelines for our building capacity.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: LT R. Lobermeier reported the following:

Yearly DOT check February 24th and 25th on trucks 240/242/243 were completed

Truck 243 is out of service until break repair completed

6-month pump maintenance completed on trucks 240/243

There were seven emergency calls in the month of February

<u>UPDATE ON TOWN ANSWERING MACHINE:</u> The town answering machine will continue to have the ability to leave a message, as well as, the Clerks/Treasurer, Road Superintendent and Town Chairman's phone numbers for items that may need immediate assistance outside of regular business hours.

THOROFARE RD:

Speed Limit: Concerns were raised by residents regarding a request to reduce the speed limit from 35 to 25 mph from RD144 to the end of Thorofare Rd. No action taken at this time, it was agreed by the board, to research and consider past and present guidelines regarding the ability for the town to make this change. The matter will be tabled and brought to a future agenda, with collected information for consideration.

Waterway sign placement: A second concern was the waterway signage for speed limit and why they were removed. There is currently multiple no wake buoys, but no actual speed limit restriction at the under bridge crossing between Pike Lake and Round Lake. Town Superintendent will research as to possible past direction to remove the signs. This will be reported at a future board meeting, prior to waterway signage being completed in spring of 2021.
