

**TOWN OF FIFIELD
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
January 20, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.**

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Felch called the meeting to order on January 20, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ROLL CALL: Present: William Felch, John Schroeder, David Ebert, Angie Richardson, Ted Fleming, and approximately 6 public attendees.

VERIFICATION OF POSTING: Clerk verified the public postings.

PUBLIC COMMENT: There were none.

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES: Minutes of January 6, 2026, were presented for review and approval. Motion made by David Ebert and seconded by John Schroeder to approve. VV 3-0.

CEMETERY FINANCIALS/REPORT: Financials were submitted for review. The Board has been informed the old mower needs work. The Crew Supervisor will check into the cost to fix and possibly replace the mower.

CLERK/TREASURER REPORT: The Clerk informed the Board of the upcoming Wisconsin Towns Association 2026 District meeting. Supervisors Ebert and Schroeder are interested in attending the meeting on February 13, 2026, in Rhinelander.

TOWN CREW REPORT: The Crew Supervisor reported on the continual winter road maintenance of plowing and sanding of the roads. He spoke with Forest Services about the plowing of Twin Lakes Campground Road area. This has now been plowed and opened to the top of the hill by the campground. Forest Services are also trying to figure out gravel for East Turner. Christmas decorations have been removed for the season and at the next meeting Crew Supervisor will have information on the cost of replacing the decorations. The crew will be working on the need to update signs. A lot has been cleared on Cys Drive, and the debris has been put into the ditch. Crew Supervisor will get fire number information to try and contact owner about clearing debris before spring.

TRANSFER SITES REPORT: Everything is good at both sites.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: Price County isn't involved with UW Madison Extension. A representative will be working on coming up with a possible report plan to help with the inventory of all township departments.

PRICE COUNTY ZONING NONMETALLIC MINING RECLAMATION RENEWAL: Documents were presented and signed by Chairman Felch.

FIRE DEPARTMENTS: Minutes from both departments were presented and reviewed. Both departments reported the number of calls they responded to for the month. Fire Department #1 will be holding its annual Cornhole Tournament Fundraiser on March 7, 2026. The Price County Fire Associations meeting will be held on January 26, 2026. Fire Department #2 Assistant Chief has completed his officers' training.

CORRESPONDENCE: A thank you note was received from the Price County Historical Society.
