

**TOWN OF FIFIELD
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
June 2, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.**

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Felch called the meeting to order on June 2, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ROLL CALL: Present: William Felch, John Schroeder, David Ebert, Angie Richardson, Ted Fleming, and approximately 6 public attendees.

VERIFICATION OF POSTING: Clerk verified the public postings.

PUBLIC COMMENT: A resident asked when the volleyball area at Movrich Park will be ready for use. Crew Supervisor updated, it will be ready this week. A resident asked when the turn around on Mickeys Road will happen. Crew Supervisor updated that it will be done and completed this summer.

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES: Minutes of May 19, 2026, were presented for review and approval. Motion made by David Ebert and seconded by John Schroeder to approve. VV 3-0.

CLERK/TREASURER REPORT: Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss reports were presented for review along with the reconciliation of general checking account. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to accept. VV 3-0. A temporary alcohol beverage license was approved for June 6, 2026, Trail Twister celebration in Movrich Park. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to accept. VV 3-0. A Archaeological permit application was signed by Chairman Felch to begin a cultural survey in Movrich Park with Wisconsin Historical Society.

ACCEPTING QUOTES FOR INSURANCE RENEWAL: Jack Vickers, Account Manager with The Horton Group, presented a proposal to renew the Town's insurance which is due on July 1, 2026.

UPDATE ON POSSIBLE SALE OF MITCHELL PROPERTY: A Land Purchase Agreement was presented to the Town Board from Christopher and Bonnie Hilgart to purchase 15.6 acres for \$30,000.00. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to accept the offer. VV 3-0. Paperwork will be drawn up by the Towns attorney.

UPDATE ON GRAVEL PIT PROPERTY: A letter was drawn up by the Towns attorney and sent requesting the removal of a structure on the Towns property. The resident was given 90 days to remove structure from the property.

TOWN CREW REPORT: Crew Supervisor reported the crew has finished chipping along roadsides since last winter. The crew started cutting North Bay Road turnaround. A message was left with the landowner, but there was no reply at the time of this meeting. The volleyball court in Movrich Park has been tilled and no additional sand is necessary. Lepke gave prices for pulverizing Sugarbush at \$7,500.00 and Old 13 Road at \$21,000.00. The Town put in its budget to do FR143, but since Lac du Flambeau isn't doing their portion of the Road, a motion was made by David Ebert and seconded by John Schroeder to use the budgeted money towards doing a half mile on FR 153-Sugarbush and Old 13 Road area from Peters Road to Trout Pond Road. VV 3-0. The necessary gravel for Sugarbush area will come from the Forest Service, from Gate Lakes Pit. No Trespassing and No Hunting signs were ordered to be posted at the gravel pit and lagoon. The cost will be shared by the Sanitary District. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to take the money from the sale of Mitchell Property and purchase the chipper that the Town rented. VV 3-0. The old chipper will be sold soon.

TRANSFER SITES REPORT: As reported at the last meeting the cost to build a storage building would be around \$10,500.00. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to pour the cement slab this year at a cost of approximately \$3,000.00. VV 3-0.

CORRESPONDENCE: An update from iWorQ was sent to start scheduling implementation of training for the new software.

REVIEW PAID INVOICES: The Board reviewed paid invoices.

ADJOURN: Motion made by David Ebert and seconded by John Schroeder to adjourn the meeting at 9:36 a.m.
