

**TOWN OF FIFIELD
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
July 7, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.**

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Felch called the meeting to order on July 7, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Fifield Town Hall. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ROLL CALL: Present: William Felch, John Schroeder, David Ebert, Angie Richardson, Ted Fleming, and approximately 6 public attendees.

VERIFICATION OF POSTING: Clerk verified the public postings.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Resident asked about replacing the sign near the Historical Society property that displays and announces the Town of Fifield upcoming events and activities. Further research will be done on this topic.

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES: Minutes of June 16, 2026, and June 17, 2026, were presented for review and approval. Motion made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to approve. VV 3-0.

CLERK/TREASURER REPORT: Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss reports were presented for review along with the reconciliation of all checking accounts. A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to accept. VV 3-0.

TOWN CREW REPORT: Crew Supervisor reported work has started on Hicks Landing Road of grubbing, shaping, seeding, and mulching. Foxy Railroad has given approval to work up to 50 feet from the crossing on Old 13 with no permit or cost. Replaced culvert on Chizch and STH70. A motion was made by David Ebert and seconded by John Schroeder to approve sending 2 crew employees to Plover for Line Tracing Training. VV 3-0. The crew has been training and compiling a list of equipment for the new iWorQ system.

TRANSFER SITES REPORT: An issue with a resident putting fish guts in the compactor at Pike Lake. They will be verifying there is a sign posted about this matter. Vendor picked up tires, mattresses, and Freon. Plan is to still try and pour cement slab this year for storage building.

GFL Environmental Garbage & Recycling Services: A vendor reached out about services available to the Town of Fifield for garbage and recycling services. An update will be given at the next meeting about our current contract with Republic Services.

Approval of Temporary Liquor License-Community Picnic: A motion was made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to approve the Temporary Liquor License for the Community Picnic on July 10 and 11, 2026. VV3-0.

CORRESPONDENCE: A resident voiced concern with the need for trees to be trimmed on Gerber Road. The crew will follow up with this matter. There will be a closing next week for the sale of land owned by the town.

REVIEW PAID INVOICES: The Board reviewed paid invoices.

ADJOURN: Motion made by John Schroeder and seconded by David Ebert to adjourn the meeting at 9:33 a.m.
